- 2. the Standard 380 of the American National Standard for Testing Airtightness of Building, Dwelling Unit, and Sleeping Unit Enclosures, Airtightness of Heating and Cooling Air Distribution Systems, and Airflow of Mechanical Ventilation Systems, commonly cited as ANSI/RESNET/ICC 380.

Part 7 of the Construction Code currently adopts by reference the 2018 edition of the International Plumbing Code (IPC), which is based on plumbing principles used in plumbing codes across the country. Part 7 also includes rules that amend the IPC that address plumbing practices that are specific to Michigan and deletes those requirements in the IPC that do not pertain to Michigan because of the State's geographic and environmental features. The proposed rules will adopt by reference the 2018 edition of the IPC with amendments, deletions, and additions deemed necessary for use in Michigan.
