On June 25, 2021, the State Fire Prevention and Building Code Council adopted a rule that amends the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code to add a new Part 1228 to Title 19 of the Official Compilation of the Codes, Rules, and Regulations of the State of New York (NYCRR). 19 NYCRR Part 1228 adds specific provisions in relation to the construction, alteration, relocation, enlargement, replacement, repair, equipment, use and occupancy, location, maintenance, removal, and demolition of rail stations. Particularly, the rule incorporates by reference a publication entitled "Uniform Code Provisions for Rail Stations" (publication date: June 2021) published by the Department of State and the reference standard "NFPA 130, Standard for Fixed Guideway Transit and Passenger Rail Systems" published by the NFPA. Effective October 12, 2021.
