The OUBCC has completed permanent rulemaking to the 2018 Editions of the International Building Code®, International Existing Building Code®, International Fire Code®, International Fuel Gas Code®, International Mechanical Code® and International Plumbing Code®; the 2017 Edition of the National Electrical Code®; and modifications to the adoption of the 2015 International Residential Code®. The final documents were published in the Oklahoma Register, Volume 38, Number 24, on September 1, 2021. The rules will become effective on September 14, 2021 and will supersede the emergency rules to the 2018 Editions of the International Building Code® and International Fire Code® and the 2017 National Electrical Code®. (Documents may be viewed by clicking the link above to the Oklahoma Register and searching the volume and number, then using the hyperlinks to the agency's documents).

North Carolina 9/14/2021 NC Council to Discuss Rulemakings

On September 14, the North Carolina Building Code Council will discuss approval of an amendment to the Code of Ordinances of the Town of North Topsail Beach for the adoption of the 2018 NC Fire Code and Appendices.

The Council will also discuss new petitions for rulemakings, including those related to retaining walls, unsafe structures and equipment, and hoistway opening protection.

Further, the Council will hold a public hearing for certain rulemaking proceedings, including those related to design professional seals, building code summary (/summaries), townhouses, double walls, common walls, automatic fire sprinkler systems, tiny houses, lofts, egress, coastal high hazard areas, and fastener corrosion resistance.

Lastly, the Council will note the final adoption of certain rulemakings (effective date being January 1, 2022), including a petition to amend the 2018 NC Administration Code, Chapters 1, 2, and 3 related to building permits, appeals to the Building Code Council, and building code enforcement, a petition to amend the 2018 NC Fire Code, Section 3103.4 relating to fire code officials and permits, a petition to amend the 2018 NC Building Code relating to increased occupant load, and a petition to add to the 2018 NC Building Code and 2018 NC Residential Code relating to tiny houses.

New Hampshire 9/10/2021 SBCRB Public Hearings

On September 10, the State Building Code Review Board will hold a public hearing for the 2018 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC 2018), model code and six carry forward amendments, 2018 International Residential Code (IRC 2018), model code and two carry forward amendments, and 2018 International Building Code Exhibit BD-18-13-21 (IBC 2018). The Board will vote on public hearing items.

The bill adds new section 55. Illinois Stretch Energy Code. The section directs the Board to create and adopt the Illinois Stretch Energy Code, to allow municipalities and projects authorized or funded by the Board to achieve more energy efficiency in buildings than the Illinois Energy Conservation Code through a consistent pathway across the State. The Illinois Stretch Energy Code shall have separate components for commercial and residential buildings, which may be adopted by the municipality jointly or separately.

The bill also amends Sec. 30. Enforcement. It adds that for purposes of the Illinois Stretch Energy Code under Section 55, the Board shall allow and encourage, as an alternative compliance mechanism, project certification by a nationally recognized nonprofit certification organization specializing in high-performance passive buildings and offering climate-specific building energy standards that require equal or better energy performance than the Illinois Stretch Energy Code.

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The proposed new division of rules in OAR chapter 340, division 271 would establish the Climate Protection Program. The purposes of the Climate Protection Program are to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from sources in Oregon, achieve co-benefits from reduced emissions of other air contaminants, and enhance public welfare for Oregon communities, particularly environmental justice communities disproportionately burdened by the effects of climate change and air contamination. To support these purposes, the proposed program:

- •Requires that covered entities reduce greenhouse gas emissions,
- •Supports reduction of emissions of other air contaminants that are not greenhouse gases,
- •Prioritizes reduction of greenhouse gases and other air contaminants in environmental justice communities,
- •Includes compliance flexibility options which help covered entities pursue the most cost effective emission

reductions, minimizing potential costs to businesses and consumers, and

•Promotes benefits in environmental justice communities
