The OUBCC emergency rules related to the 2018 IBC and IEBC expired on September 14, 2022. Emergency rules require permanent rulemking to supersede the emergency rules to make them permanent. Permanent rulemkaing was started, however, based on written public comments received during the rulemaking public comment period; and public comments made at the public hearing on March 31, 2022, the OUBCC elected to stop rulemaking and allow the emergency rules to expire without being superseceded by permanent rules. The requirements that were amended, go back to the way they were adopted in the original IBC and IEBC adoptions in 2021.

This bill would require the commission, commencing with the next triennial edition of the California Building Standards Code adopted after January 1, 2023, to adopt, approve, codify, and publish mandatory building standards for fire resistance based on occupancy risk categories in very high, high, and moderate California fire severity zones in state responsibility areas, local responsibility areas, and in land designated as a Wildland-Urban Interface Fire Area by cities and other local agencies under the California Building Standards Code, as specified. The bill would require the building standards to apply to nonresidential, critical infrastructure buildings and to include certain requirements, including fire rating requirements for structures under specified risk categories
