Whether it is through our Society or through some other pro-gas association. ASGE sent out an email correspondence from Dave Delaquila on how to get involved and get information from ASHRAE. We, as a Society have a unique opportunity to speak directly to our industry, and without continued growth through membership and active participation we cannot impact our industry; and with the current electrification and decarbonization push at all political levels, this is extremely important... we must stress involvement and active participation.


Finally, Nancy's conclusion in a few words was simply the following:
