On October 1, 2022, the 2022 Oregon Structural Specialty Code (OSSC) became effective, with a 6-month phase-in period ending March 31, 2023. During the phase-in period, the use of the 2019 OSSC or the 2022 OSSC is permitted. The 2022 OSSC is based on the 2021 International Building Code (IBC) and the 2021 International Existing Building Code (IEBC) with integrated new construction provisions of the 2021 International Fire Code (IFC) and Oregon-specific amendments.

The Department of Community Affairs proposes to amend and supplement the licensing provisions of the Uniform Construction Code (UCC) to incorporate certification of technical assistants to the construction official. This proposed rulemaking would create an initial application fee and a triennial renewal fee to offset the administration of these changes. As the Department has issued an informal, non-renewable, and voluntary certification for 20 years, this rulemaking also incorporates a provision that those individuals need to apply for the formal certification, but do not need to repeat the educational component. The requirements for the certification are largely the same as those that existed under the voluntary program.
