This rule adds that local governments are charged with the administration and enforcement of the Uniform Code and the Energy Code. A local government has the option to decline that responsibility by adopting a local law to that effect, in which event the responsibility passes to the respective county. Counties are accorded a similar option. If a local government and a county each exercise their option, the statute provides for administration and enforcement of the Uniform Code and Energy Code by the Secretary of State in the place and stead of the local government. The rule establishes the procedures applicable in the circumstances in which the Secretary of State, through the Department of State, will administer and enforce the Uniform Code and Energy Code in the place and stead of a local government or county.
