The bill extends the compliance periods for adoption and enforcement of the model energy codes by a rural county as follows: (1) an energy code that achieves equivalent or better energy performance than the 2021 international energy conservation code and the model electric-ready and solar-ready code language developed by the energy board is not required prior to July 1, 2030; (2) an energy code that achieves equivalent or better energy and carbon emissions performance than the model low energy and carbon code developed by the energy board is not required prior to July 1, 2032; and (3) an energy code that achieves equivalent or better energy performance than one of the 3 most recent editions of the international energy conservation code is not required prior to July 1, 2025.

It also requires the state building code council to establish codes and standards consistent with the goal of reducing greenhouse gas emissions associated with hydrofluorocarbons when updating the state building code.
