

HB 6	MD	"Department of General Services – Energy–Conserving Standards (Maryland Sustainable Buildings Act of 2023)"	Terri Hill	Hearing 2/08 at 2:30 p.m. (Health and Government Operations)	1/20/2023
<p>The bill directs the Department of General Services to establish and periodically update standards for State buildings to conserve energy and minimize adverse impacts on birds. It also requires the Maryland Green Building Council to include the standards in any requirements established for participation in a higher-performance building program in the State. Finally, it defines "State building" as one acquired, constructed, or renovated by the State or one for which 50% of the money for acquisition, construction, or renovation came from State funds.</p>					
HB 23-1085	CO	"Rural County and Municipality Energy Efficient Building Codes"	Matthew Martinez	Introduced In House - Assigned to Energy & Environment	1/19/2023
<p>This bill requires counties and municipalities are currently required to adopt and enforce certain energy-efficient building codes concurrently with the updating of their existing building codes or, before July 1, 2023 only, concurrently with either the adoption or updating of their building codes. The bill extends the compliance periods for adoption and enforcement of the model energy codes by a rural county as follows: (1) an energy code that achieves equivalent or better energy performance than the 2021 international energy conservation code and the model electric-ready and solar-ready code language developed by the energy board is not required prior to July 1, 2030; (2) an energy code that achieves equivalent or better energy and carbon emissions performance than the model low energy and carbon code developed by the energy board is not required prior to July 1, 2032; and (3) an energy code that achieves equivalent or better energy performance than one of the 3 most recent editions of the international energy conservation code is not required prior to July 1, 2025.</p>					
HB 197	HI	"Relating To Climate Change Mitigation."	Nicole Lowen	Introduced and Pass First Reading.	1/19/2023
<p>This bill directs the department of health to establish a refrigerant management program to reduce emissions of high global warming potential refrigerants and any refrigerant that is an ozone-depleting substance from the operation of stationary, commercial, and industrial refrigeration equipment responsible and adopt rules for the regulation of the use of such refrigerants. It also requires the state building code council to establish codes and standards consistent with the goal of reducing greenhouse gas emissions associated with hydrofluorocarbons when updating the state building code.</p>

<p>This bill requires government entities in the State that issue building permits to implement SolarAPP+ or a functionally equivalent online automated permitting platform that verifies code compliance and issues permits to licensed contractors for solar distributed energy resource systems in real time by 1/1/2024. It also requires government entities in the State that issue building permits to adopt self-certification for solar distributed energy resource systems that are not SolarAPP+ compatible.</p>					
SB 92	MD	"Department of General Services – Energy–Conserving Standards (Maryland Sustainable Buildings Act of 2023)"	Clarence Lam	Hearing 2/02 at 2:00 p.m.	1/19/2023
<p>The bill directs the Department of General Services to establish and periodically update standards for State buildings to conserve energy and minimize adverse impacts on birds. It also requires the Maryland Green Building Council to include the standards in any requirements established for participation in a higher-performance building program in the State. <p>This bill provides that it is the intent of the Legislature to enact subsequent legislation to create building performance standards for improvements in energy efficiency and reductions in the emissions of greenhouse gases in large buildings, including measures to ensure that making the necessary investments to improve these buildings will improve equity and avoid displacement or increased energy burdens.</p>

<p>This bill adopts the following building codes: the International Building Code (IBC), chapter 13 of the 2021 6 edition, and all but such chapter of the 2018 edition, except 101.4.3 and chapter 29; and the International Residential Code (IRC), chapter 11 of the 2021 12 edition, and all but such chapter of the 2018 edition, except section 13 R313 and chapters 25 through 33. A local building or construction code shall be deemed to conform generally with the state building code if it adopts Chapter 13 of the 2021 edition of the International Building Code, or Chapter 11 of the 2021 edition of the International Residential Code.</p>
