The New York State Department of State is proposing amendments to amend and update Part 1205 of the Uniform Code: Variance and Appeals Procedures (19 NYCRR Part 1205). Specifically, the rule in development would: add definitions and for clarification; and add a process for alternative compliance cases to allow the use of the design, construction, and maintenance provisions or requirements of a nationally recognized standard or code that is not expressly allowed by the Uniform Code. The rule will be published in the New York State Register on March 29, with the public comment period ending on June 5, as well as with a public Hearing to be held on May 31.

These amendments must achieve a net zero energy standard for new commercial buildings by 2038 and thereafter.
