



Summary: This bill inserts net zero energy requirements for large residential and mixed-use construction projects receiving Fund assistance; the Clean Energy DC Building Code Amendment Act of 2022 to require periodic reporting on the development of universal net zero energy building code regulations that will apply to residential and mixed-use construction; and the Green Building Act of 2006 to remove those net zero energy compliance provisions inserted by the Greener Government Buildings Amendment Act of 2022 that apply to residential and mixed-use projects.

Summary: This proposed rule outlines minimum safety and design standards for pools and spas, with provisions based on the 2024 International Swimming Pool and Spa Code (ISPSC). It specifies that concrete finishes for pool interiors must be white or light-colored and comply with the Munsell gray scale, ensuring clarity for safety purposes. Decking around pools and spas must be slipresistant, with at least 90% perimeter access, and a clearance of 4 feet around diving equipment. Railings for deck steps are required for public pools and spas, and decking surfaces must meet specific slip-resistance standards. Additionally, decks between pools and spas must maintain a minimum width of 6 feet. This provision exempts spray pads, splash pads, private residential pools, apartment complex pools, country club pools, subdivision pools, pools focused on external body cleansing, therapeutic pools at licensed facilities, therapeutic chambers cleaned after each use, and religious ritual baths from these rules.

These amendments are proposed to reflect updates, corrections, or wording changes with the adoption of the 2021 editions of the International Codes, including the International Building Code (IBC), International Energy Conservation Code (IECC), International Mechanical Code (IMC), International Residential Code (IRC), and the National Standard Plumbing Code (NSPC), as well as the 2020 edition of the National Electrical Code, and the associated referenced standards.
