

Number of Bills Per Issue




Number of Regulations Per Issue

September 27, 2024 **Summary:** This bill focuses on fire safety regulations for lithium-ion batteries in California. The bill requires the State Fire Marshal to propose updates to the fire standards for lead-acid and nickelcadmium battery systems to also include identical requirements for lithium-ion batteries. These updates must be proposed before the next triennial edition of the California Building Standards Code adopted after January 1, 2025. The Legislature intends that no additional requirements, beyond those described in the bill, are included in the updated battery requirement regulations. **Location:** US-CA

Summary: The final rule (24.301.172) rule incorporates the 2021 edition of the International Mechanical Code (IMC) while making several modifications, including replacing references to the International Plumbing Code with the Uniform Plumbing Code. The final rule (24.301.401) adopts the 2020 edition of the National Fire Protection Association Standard NFPA 70, known as the National Electrical Code, incorporating it by reference unless a different edition is specified. This code establishes minimum standards and requirements for electrical installations nationwide. The final rule (24.301.154) adopts the 2021 edition of the International Residential Code, incorporating it by reference. This code sets forth minimum standards and requirements for detached one- or twofamily dwellings and multiple single-family dwellings (townhouses) not more than three stories above grade in height, and their accessory structures. The final rule (24.301.161) adopts the 2021 edition of the International Energy Conservation Code incorporating it by reference unless a different edition is specified. This code is a model code for the energy efficient construction of buildings. **Location:** US-MT
