<p>The final version of the 2025 Colorado Wildfire Resiliency Code has been released and is set for adoption on July 1, 2025, along with an accompanying statewide application map. Draft rules (8 CCR 1507-39) to implement the code are now open for public feedback, with written comments due by June 18, 2025. A public hearing and stakeholder session will be held on June 27, 2025, from 9:00–10:00 a.m., followed by a Board meeting from 10:00 a.m.–3:00 p.m. to consider revisions; both events will be conducted in a hybrid format.</p>		

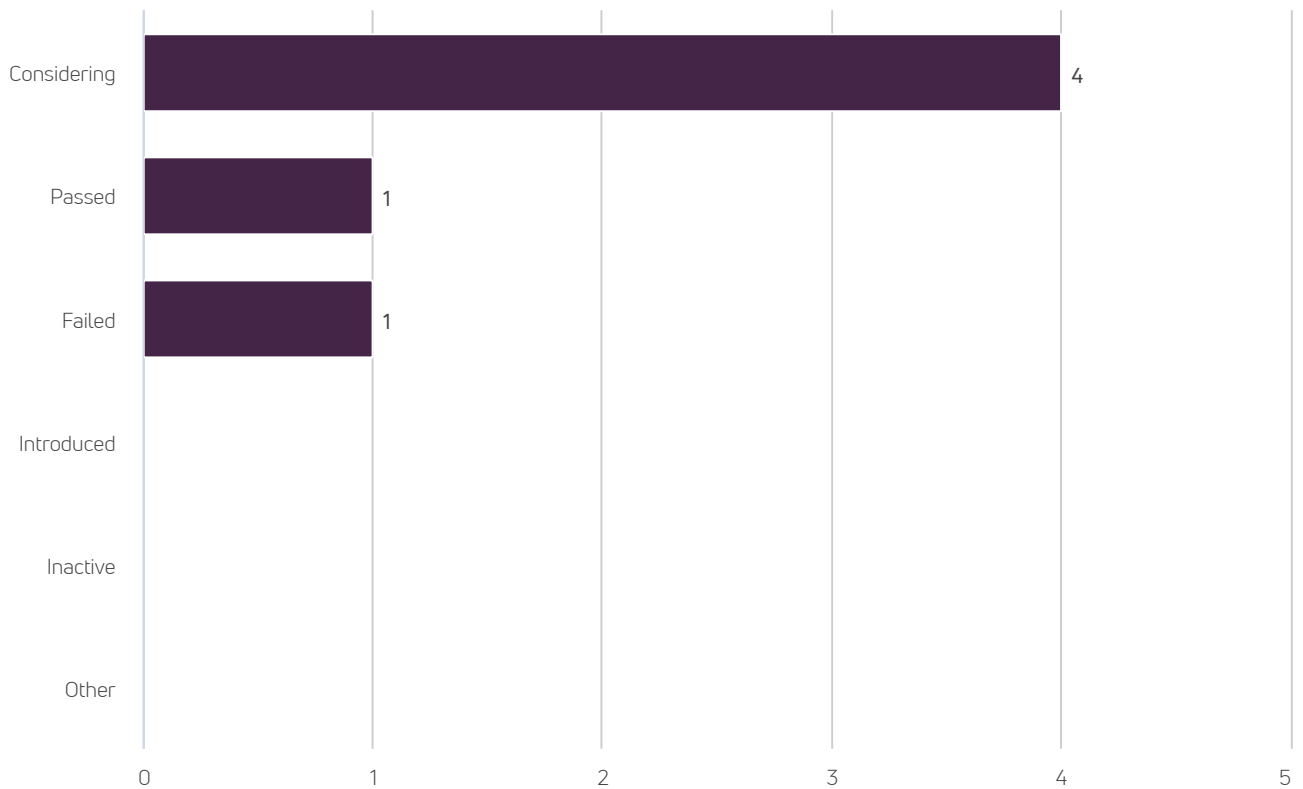

Bills by Status

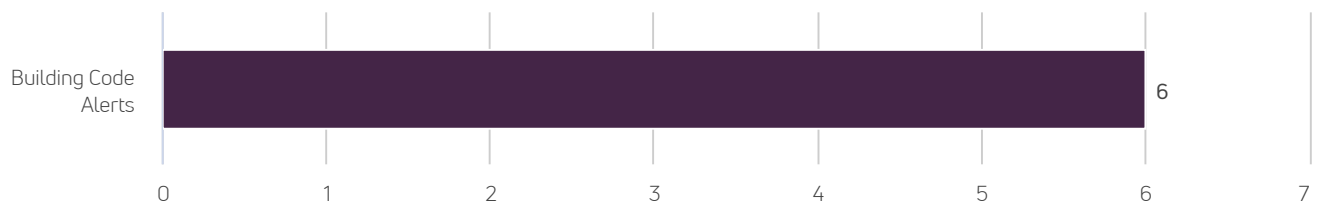

Number of Bills Per Issue

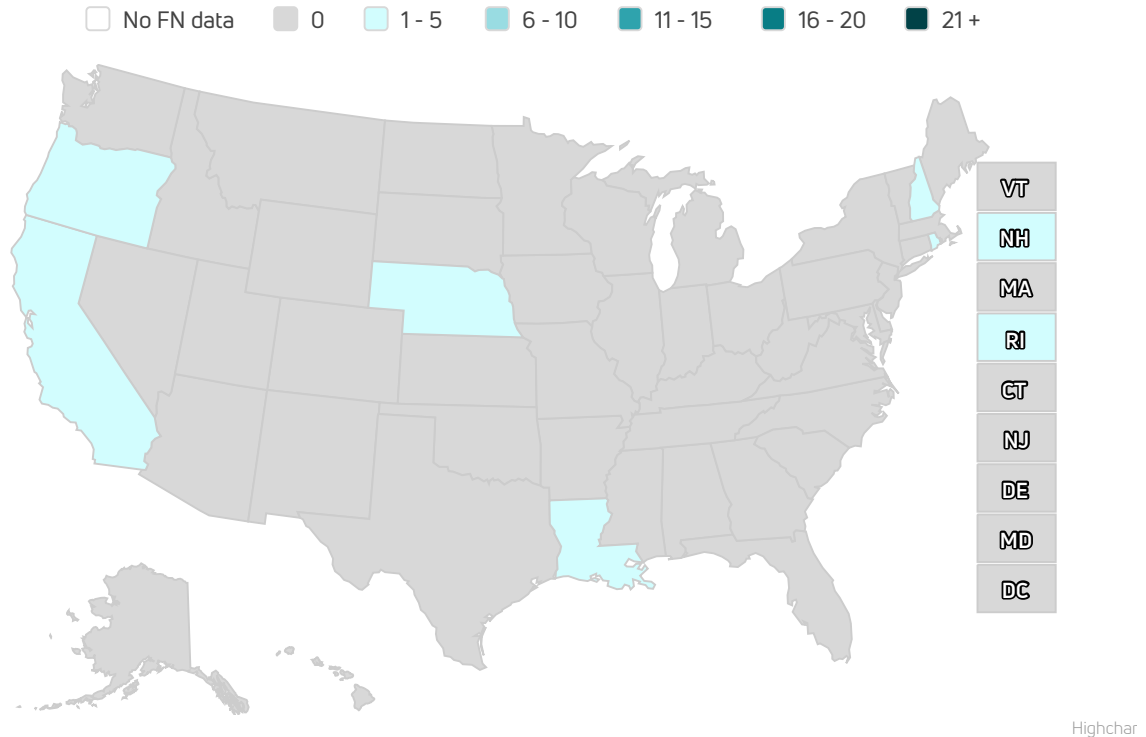

LA HB 85

Title: BUILDING CODES: Provides relative to permits for construction (RE SEE FISC NOTE LF EX)

Current Status: Considering

Introduction Date: March 20, 2025

Last Action Date: Received from the Senate without amendments.. June 08, 2025

Summary: Present law provides for the enforcement of building codes by municipalities and parishes. Proposed law retains present law and adds that any municipality or parish which issues a permit for construction pursuant to proposed law shall do all of the following: (1) Permit and inspect all buildings, other than one- and two-family dwellings, for roof construction and reroofing in compliance with the International Building Code Chapter 15 requirements as adopted and promulgated by the Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code. (2) Permit and inspect one- and two-family dwellings for roof construction and reroofing in compliance with the International Residential Code Chapter 8 and 9 requirements as adopted and promulgated by the Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code. (3) Provide, upon request, individual permit data.

OR SB 862

Title: Relating to fire protection.

Current Status: Passed

Introduction Date: January 13, 2025

Last Action Date: Effective date, January 1, 2026.. June 06, 2025

Summary: This bill requires the Department of the State Fire Marshal to adopt a base fire prevention code, known as the Oregon Fire Code, and mandates that this code be made publicly available electronically. It also makes amendments to existing laws regarding fire districts, including provisions for rural fire protection districts. The bill allows fire districts to acquire property for establishing fire evacuation routes and to operate emergency medical services in accordance with county plans.

CA SB 655

Title: Residential building standards: indoor temperature.

Current Status: Considering

Introduction Date: February 20, 2025

Last Action Date: In Assembly. Read first time. Held at Desk.. June 05, 2025

Summary: This bill mandates updates to California's energy code by requiring the California Building Standards Commission to adopt passive and active cooling strategies to maintain a maximum indoor temperature of 82°F in new residential buildings by July 1, 2026. It also directs the Department of Housing and Community Development to develop a load calculation methodology for heating and cooling in all climate zones. These updates will be incorporated into the next triennial California Building Standards Code update and reported to the Legislature by January 1, 2027.

RI SB 1002

Title: An Act Relating To State Affairs And Government -- Rebuild Rhode Island Tax Credit (Amends Provisions Related To The Maximum Project Credit Allowed Under The Rebuild Rhode Island Tax Credit For Certain Qualified Development Projects.)

Current Status: Considering

Introduction Date: May 02, 2025

Last Action Date: Senate passed Sub A as amended (floor amendment). June 04, 2025

Summary: This bill would amend provisions related to the maximum project credit allowed under the Rebuild Rhode Island tax credit for certain qualified development projects.

NH HB 428

Title: (New Title) relative to the state building code.

Current Status: Considering

Introduction Date: January 10, 2025

Last Action Date: Speaker Appoints: Reps. S. Pearson, Sheehan, Grote, C. McGuire 05/22/2025
HJ 15. June 03, 2025

Summary: This bill prohibits local legislative bodies from making any amendments to the state building code.

NE LB 531

Title: LB531 - Provide an exception to the requirement that buildings constructed with state funds comply with the 2018 International Energy Conservation Code

Current Status: Failed

Introduction Date: January 22, 2025

Last Action Date: Indefinitely postponed. June 02, 2025

Summary: This bill amends existing Nebraska statutes related to building codes, specifically concerning the requirements for projects funded by the Affordable Housing Trust Fund. It provides an exception to the mandate that buildings constructed with state funds must comply with the 2018 International Energy Conservation Code. Under this legislation, the Department of Economic Development is prohibited from enforcing compliance with this energy code for new construction or rental conversion projects that receive funding from the Affordable Housing Trust Fund.
